



# Lights Out

Save Birds • Save Energy • Save Money



The Indigo Bunting, American Redstart, and Yellow-bellied Sapsucker are 3 of Minnesota's 250 migratory bird species that benefit from Lights Out.

Over 250 species of birds migrate through Minnesota each year. Bright nighttime building lights can lure them off track and into deadly building collisions.

## How you can help

During bird migration (August 15 - October 31 and March 15 - May 31) from midnight until dawn:

- Turn off exterior decorative lighting
- Turn off interior lights – especially upper floors
- If you work at night, use task lighting rather than overhead lighting, or close the blinds
